

**ZONE 6 COORDINATING COMMITTEE
AWARDS RULES
2012 DEEP SOUTH ZONE-O-RAMA **March 17-18, 2012****

****IT IS THE EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO BE AWARE OF THESE RULES****

Points for awards will be accumulated on a 6-5-4-3-2-1 basis (maximum being 6 points) depending on the number of entries in the class (e.g., 3 entries, 1st place will receive 3 points). **Tiebreaker** to be the most 1st, 2nd, etc. and by a tiebreaker judge if necessary in all awards, **including Zone 6 Novice Youth awards**. No points when disqualified.

APHA Zone High-Point Trophy for Open, Amateur & Youth will follow Zone 6 Hi-Point rules except as specifically detailed in APHA Zone High-Point Trophy Rules. **Open Solid Paint-Bred** will follow *APHA Zone High-Point Trophy Rules*.

APHA Zone 6 Novice Youth Awards Only Zone 6 Youth are Eligible for this award. Novice Youth must have a current Novice Youth Card and only show in Novice Youth Classes. Awards include: **Buckle**, for All Around Novice Youth Champion; **Lasered Leather Corner Saddle Pad** for Reserve All Around Novice Youth Champion; **Arena Bag/Garment Bag** for third place All Around Novice Youth Champion. Novice Youth must show in at least 3 Novice Youth Classes with no particular class mandatory. 1 horse - 1 exhibitor. SC-145 A.2.-4 and 1st paragraph above.

Hi-Point Awards and Reserve Hi-Point Awards

Deep South ZOR Hi-Point and Reserve Hi-Point Awards will be given for: Open Horse; Youth Walk Trot; Novice Youth; Youth 13 & Under; Youth 14-18; Amateur Walk Trot, Novice Amateur and Amateur.

The Hi-Point and Reserve Hi-Point in each category will have accumulated the most points and 2nd most points under all 6 judges.

To Qualify for the:

Open Hi-Point, a horse must be shown in 3 open performance classes **and** the respective open halter class and may be shown by more than one exhibitor.

Youth 13 & Under & Youth 14-18 Hi-Point, the youth must show in any 3 youth performance classes **and** youth mares or youth geldings – 1 horse–1 exhibitor - – if different ex. in each division, halter points are required and go with the ex. showing in halter and not required in the other division.

Youth Walk-Trot Hi-Point, the youth must show in 3 youth walk-trot classes. Youth mares or youth geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory – 1 horse-1 exhibitor.

Novice Youth Hi-Point must show in 3 novice youth performance classes. Youth mares or youth geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory - 1 horse – 1 exhibitor

Amateur Hi-Point, the amateur must show in any 3 amateur performance classes **and** amateur mares, stallions or geldings - 1 horse - 1 exhibitor.

Amateur Walk-Trot Hi-Point, the amateur must show in 3 amateur walk-trot classes. Amateur mares, stallions or geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory - 1 horse - 1 exhibitor.

Novice Amateur Hi-Point, the novice must show in any 3 novice am performance classes. Amateur mares, stallions or geldings will count for points if shown but is not mandatory - 1 horse - 1 exhibitor.

If the youth or amateur is exhibiting a different horse in the qualifying halter class, the halter requirement is considered to be met but those halter points will not count. **Please notify the show secretary.**

High Point Open and Amateur Stallion, Mare and Gelding and Youth Mare and Gelding Halter Awards The Open High Point Stallion, Mare and Gelding Halter Awards will be given to the horse in each division receiving the most APHA points per APHA rule SC-060 & SC-065.

Added Money Classes / Overall Class High Point Including High Point/Youth (MG)

If an Overall Class High Point Award or Added Money Award is given in a class, it will be given to the exhibitor receiving the most points under all 6 judges as per points discussed in the first paragraph including the tiebreaker provisions.

Added Money will be distributed as follows unless a different calculation is noted for a particular class – for example 3 Year Old Western Pleasure, Classic Amateur Western Pleasure and Gamblin on Trail in Tunica. Results will be verified and checks will be mailed within 3 weeks. Payee, SS No. or EIN, Phone No and mailing address must be complete on entry form to receive a check.

\$999 and Under first 50%; second 30%; third 20%.

\$1,000 and Over first to 40%; second 22.5%; third 15%; fourth 10%; fifth 7.5%; sixth 5%.

**** GREEN CLASSES - CLARIFICATION:** No Green Classes will count for any high point offered per the Green Class rules.
